I am required to bee a commissioner tomorow at Lichf: Vpon an inquirie out of the Exchequier for recusant{es}. Warrant is q̄ graunted vnto the sheriff of this Countie to inpanell a Iurie and the place appoynted by m<sup>r</sup> Leigh is Lichfield I praye your opinion whether any such enquirie bee good in lawe beeing taken in an other Countie and whether there bee auctoritie in the sheriff to sommon a iurie thether for there appance. I haue no mynd to the busines and wold willinglie haue a clenlie shift to avoyde yt.
