Mr sheiriefe I receved by Newes your bayliefte yesternight last  
notice of a Iurie to be impanelled Concerning Certen landes of myne  
lieng in Typton. the service to be don on thursday next. the matter  
Concernes me verie much. the landes lieing in a parke vnder my  
house syde, now the tyme being so shorte, my request ys that yt  
may please you to do me the favor to stay the *proceedeing* of the  
Cavse vntill the next vacation, against *which* tyme I shalbe redye  
for the same, *which* kindnes yf yt please you I rest my selfe to requite  
att my house at Hymley this xiiii<sup>th</sup> of Ianuarie 1603
