George Mabancke & Rose ffoster dwellinge in the lodge at Henlie  
parke doe willfullie refuse to come to the churche contrarie to  
her Ma<sup>t(es)}</sup> lawes in that case pvided Theis are by vertewe of  
her Ma<sup>t(es)}</sup> Co<sup>m</sup>ission to vs and others directed to charge and  
co<sup>m</sup>aunde you to warne all the said psons psonallie to appeare  
before vs at Guildforde on saterdaie the xv<sup>th</sup> of this pte  
Ianuarie by nine of the clocke in the fore noone then & there to  
answere to such matters as on the behalf of her Ma<sup>tie</sup> shalbe  
obiected or demaunded of them. And hereof faile you not at yor  
pills ./.
