George Mabancke & Rose ffoster dwellinge in the lodge at Henlie
parke doe willfullie refuse to come to the churche contrarie to
her Ma^{t(es)} lawes in that case pvided Theis are by vertewe of
her Ma^{t(es)} Co^mission to vs and others directed to charge and
co^maunde you to warne all the said psons psonallie to appeare
before vs at Guildforde on saterdaie the xvth of this pte
Ianuarie by nine of the clocke in the fore noone then & there to
answere to such matters as on the behalf of her Ma^{tie} shalbe
obiected or demaunded of them. And hereof faile you not at yor
pills ./.
