Where as we are enformed that Roger Borrowe, Thomas Thorpe George Mabancke & Rose ffoster dwellinge in the lodge at Henlie parke doe willfullie refuse to come to the churche contrarie to her Maiesties lawes in that case provided Theis are by vertewe of her Maiesties Commission to vs and others directed to charge and commaunde you to warne all the said persons personallie to appeare before vs at Guildforde on saterdaie the xvth of this parte lanuarie by nine of the clocke in the fore noone then & there to answere to such matters as on the behalf of her Maiestie shalbe objected or demaunded of them. And hereof faile you not at your perills ./.
