Where as we are enformed that Roger Borrowe, Thomas Thorpe
George Mabancke & Rose ffoster dwellinge in the lodge at Henlie
parke doe willfullie refuse to come to the churche contrarie to
her *Maiesties* lawes in that case *provided* Theis are by vertewe of
her *Maiesties* Commission to vs and others directed to charge and
commaunde you to warne all the said *persons personallie* to appeare
before vs at Guildforde on saterdaie the xvth of this *parte*
Ianuarie by nine of the clocke in the fore noone then & there to
answere to such matters as on the behalf of her *Maiestie* shalbe
obiected or demaunded of them. And hereof faile you not at your
perills ./.
